Consent by parent or legal guardian

Are you applying for a Dutch passport for a child under the age of 18 years? Or a Dutch identity card for a child up to the age of 12 years? Then all of the people who have parental responsibility (parents or legal guardians) must give permission.

Complete the form, print it and sign it. You must also provide a clear copy of a valid form of identification. The signature on the consent form must match the signature on the identity document.
